The following file has the purpose to summarize the admission requirements/ application procedures/ deadlines and fees.

## Bachelor of Arts (3 years program) in:

- Design (Interior, Industrial)
- Fashion and Textile Design
- Theatre Design
- Graphic Design and Art Direction
- Media Design (Computer Animation, Film and Video)
- Visual Arts (Painting, Videoart, Photography, Public Art)

## TUITION FEE :

- EU Citizens (it includes Turkey, Iceland and Norway) 7500 €, divided in Enrollment fee 1500 € (deadline June 1<sup>st</sup>) and tuition fee 6000 € (deadline October 5<sup>th</sup>)
- Non EU Citizens 9500 €, divided in Enrollment fee 1500 € (deadline June 1<sup>st</sup>) and tuition fee 8000 € (deadline October 5<sup>th</sup>)
- Alternative schedule program with classes between 5.30 and 9.30 pm (for the BA Program in Fashion and Textile Design, Graphic Design and Art Direction and Design) 5000 €, divided in Enrollment fee 1500 € (deadline June 1<sup>st</sup>) and tuition fee 3500 € (deadline October 5<sup>th</sup>)

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: For both EU and non-EU students

- to have completed a 12 years education cycle  
**(PLEASE ENQUIRE AT NEAREST ITALIAN EMBASSY REGARDING VALIDITY)**
- translation, legalization and value declaration certificate of the high school diploma (completed by Italian authorities in the student's home country)
- **LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT** – Candidates must complete and document the following language requirement:
  - Oriental and Middle Eastern students: 500 hrs
  - Eastern European Students: 360 hrs
  - Other Europeans: 320 hrs
  - Spanish and Portuguese speaking students: 160 hrs

NABA suggests to start a course of Italian in your home country as soon as you decide to apply. NABA can also assist you in gaining all levels of language preparation through a network of selected school. Please ask us about it. (Please notice that NABA students attending any of these selected schools, are entitled to a privileged fare when attending this school) In order to complete the language requirement NABA suggests to come to Italy some months prior to the beginning of the academic year to achieve the requested level of Italian.

Diploma auto-certification/original

Form provided by the Italian embassy  
(for both EU and NON EU citizens)  
This form can be called Modulo A Bis, Modulo B bis, Modulo C bis, Modulo D bis, Modulo E bis, Modulo F bis, Modulo G bis, Modulo H bis, Modulo L bis.

Original of the high school diploma

Diploma translation, legalization and Value Declaration Certificate (**ask for "DICHIARAZIONE DI VALORE"**) issued by Italian Embassy/Consulate

Application Form and Receipt of the enrollment fee payment (1.500 Euros)

## DEADLINE

Between April 15th and May 15th : to be presented to the Italian local Embassy/Consulate.  
This deadline is referred to NON EU citizens.  
EU citizens must take care of it, but can do it later as well.

April 15th/May 15th. Fill in the form and submit it together with the diploma or auto-certification to Italian Embassy to get the documents specified below.  
The form that you will be given, will vary according to your residency status.

In case you could not present the original of your high school diploma, within July 15th take it to local Italian representative authorities. (Check the deadline with them).

Within July 30th To be delivered to NABA by Italian Embassy/Consulate.  
Please enquire at Italian authorities if they will send it directly to NABA or they will give it to you. If so it will be your duty to send it to NABA.
